### **OVERVIEW**

### What is the RSL Challenge?

The RSL Challenge is a friendly fundraising competition between the regional, state and local societies where the region that donates the most to the AAAAI Foundation in 2019 will receive free certification for a 2020 CME course.

### **Reasons to Compete**

- Because your region can win free CME certification that's a \$2,500 value!
- To support allergy and asthma research that leads to improved patient care.
- To show off your regional pride the winning region will be highlighted at the upcoming 2020 AAAAI Annual Meeting and on the Foundation's website.

### **Challenge Outline**

Every gift made in 2019 to the AAAAI Foundation, can be counted toward the RSL Challenge. Gifts must be designated to a specific region at the time of donation – either online or via check.


The RSL Board of Governors will review the donation tallies at the end of the year. The winning region's Governor will choose the specific society to earn the CME certification in February of 2020. The winning region will be notified in March of 2020.

- Region 7, Western (CA and HI)


### **HOW TO DONATE**

- Offer to match each gift up to a certain amount or the number of donations, i.e. "I will donate \$5 for every member who donates to the RSL Challenge".

### **Quick Donation Facts:**

- During 2019, the AAAAI Foundation will support 11 grants totaling over \$680,000. The support for these multi-year awards is only possible through continued support from our donors.
- 2018 Grant Impact Study Results \$4.7 million granted as a major award since 1993. \$66 million more granted to our awardees after Foundation provided initial support.
- 90% of our major awardees have achieved permanent Allery/Immunology faculty positions.
